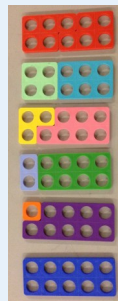
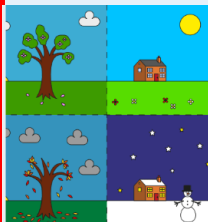


Year 1 Autumn 1

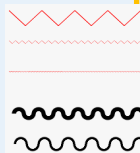
Maths: This year we are starting by consolidating our knowledge of numbers 1-10. Comparing numbers by using the language of greater than and less than and equal to. Number bonds will be a big focus for us this half term with a lot of practical opportunities in our lessons and in provision challenges.



Science: Seasons, the perfect way to start our learning in science this half term. Starting with looking at the weather and how weather changes during the seasons. Over the whole half term we will be looking at the daylight hours and we will be working scientifically to record the daylight hour changes.

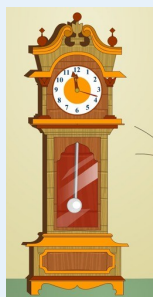


Art: Following on from the wonderful work the children did in drawing club in reception our Art topic will start with us 'Making our Mark'. The children will look at the work of Bridget Riley and how she has used lines to create different effects. Before seeing what they can create using a similar technique.

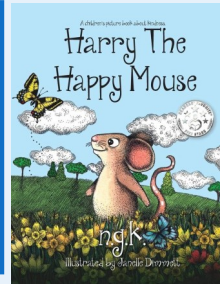


Computing: Mouse Skills - Our focus is learning how to use a computer, logging in and using a mouse to drag and move objects and use a simple program using the mouse.

Music: My Musical Heartbeat is our theme for this half term. We will be exploring sounds, listening and responding to music, singing and using instruments alongside our song.

Religion and Worldviews: How did the world begin? For our topic this term will be looking at what different religions believe on this topic and how people believe different things and we respect that.

English: Our English starts with looking at the Nursery Rhyme Hickory Dickory Dock. We will be using this rhyme to help us create a similar rhyme to learn of by heart. The theme of a mouse will continue as we move onto reading 'Harry the Happy Mouse'. We will learn about Harry and his helpfulness throughout this story. Children will explore the meaning of different words used throughout the story and will be uses these in verbal and written sentences.



Phonics: We are continuing to use the Read Write Inc. scheme to teach phonics. We are split into smaller groups from our assessments and learn new to read new sounds and books based on our ability. Reading books will be sent home that link directly to the focus book they have been learning in their groups and practice sounds or words will be sent too.

Geography: What is it like here?

We will be looking at our immediate area and seeing how we can make a map to represent the area we are in. We will be using different methods to create a map by looking at objects from a birds eye view.

PE: Fundamental Skills: this session we will be completing a baseline assessment on skills such as running, jumping, throwing and catching.

Gymnastics: we will be developing the skills of travelling, rolling, and jumping into a sequence with two different shapes using apparatus.



PSHE: Families and relationships

We will be looking at how families are different but how every family is special. We will also spend time talking about different emotions and how these emotions are something we all feel at times.
