

Year 1 Summer 2

Maths: We will start the term by introducing numbers 50-100. We will be working on our ability to count, recognise numbers, recognise the amount of 10s and 1s and use these numbers in simple additions. Then we will be moving onto money, looking at different coins and notes to be able to recognise the worth and how we can use money. Ending the half term looking at time, looking at hours and half hours on a clock.

Science:

Our focus this term is "Working Scientifically". We will be using our learning from across Year 1 to: investigate trees, compare woodland animals, measure footprints, build animal homes and identify carnivores, herbivores and omnivores

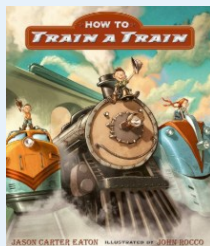
Art: our artists will be learning primary and secondary colours, colour mixing techniques, and applying these skills in painting and printing. We will enhance understanding of colours and their applications in art.



Computing: we are going to be learning about data, why it is useful and the different ways it can be gathered and recorded by ourselves but also with the help of computers.



Music: Our focus this term is "How music teaches us to look after our planet" As part of this we will be learning new songs and attempting to use glockenspiels to add to our performances.

Religion and Worldviews: we are going to be looking at what different religions and worldviews believe about why we should care for each other. And what the different scriptures can tell us about caring for each

PSHE: Our main focus in PSHE will be supporting the children in the preparation for moving up into Year 2. Reflecting on Year 1 and looking ahead to the next step in their school journey.

English: In English we are going to look at 'How to train a train' book. We will be learning about trains, researching different facts about trains. We will be presenting an idea for a Cbeebies show about trains. We will be revisiting the skills of using 'and' 'but' and learning how to use 'or' in a sentence.

Phonics: Phonics screening is happening this half term. Children will continue to be taught phonics based on their current reading ability. Reading books will be sent home that link directly to the focus book they have been learning in their group.

Geography: What is it like in Shanghai is our topic this half term. We will be starting looking at our local area of Longridge and then looking at the area of Windermere to link with our trip and finally we will be locating Shanghai on a map and exploring what it is like there.



PE: This half term we are going to be refining all the skills we are been learning this year. We are going to revisiting all the key skills we have learnt this year and applying them in game and athletics activities.
